## STEAM Update


### Student Led Clubs

In November, students will explore the Science of vibrations and how they create different sounds depending on size and materials involved as we create instruments using a variety of materials from our Innovation Lab.



Some of the grade fives have started to design 3D objects in Tinkercad and these will come together to create a single design to be sold at the Holiday market coming up on November 29<sup>th</sup> with all proceeds going towards the new playground. Other grade 5 classes will get a chance to learn about 3D printing in the new year.

## LLS Career Fair


### Career Fair Volunteers Needed!

Our Lions are heading into their **Friendship Era!** This month, we will be exploring what friendship means and how we can be good friends to others. At home, families can help reinforce what friendship *looks like*, and *sounds like* by talking about ways to show kindness, respect, and care toward others.

- Listen and be kind.

It's important for students to understand that disagreements with friends are normal. What matters most is how we handle them. When something bothers us, we can use an **"I Statement"** to express our feelings respectfully. For example:

*"I felt sad when you said you would sit with me on the bus, but you sat with someone else."*

If we make a mistake, it's important to take responsibility and apologize. That might sound like:

*"I'm sorry I sat with someone else when I said I'd sit with you. Let's make a plan to sit together tomorrow."*

When home and school work together, we can help our students develop the friendship skills they need to build positive relationships — now and in the future.
